EVICTIONS IN IRELAND AND DISPOSSESS WARRANTS IN NEW YORK.

In the year 1880, 4000 ejectment processes were issued in Ireland. This number exceeds that of any previous or subsequent year. It is computed that the average family consists of five members, therefore the number of the "evicted" was about 20,000. In 1880 Ireland had a population of about 5,000,000; and the number of the evicted was one to two hundred and fifty. During the same year in the city of New York 11,280 "dispossess, warrants," equivalent to ejectment warrants in Ireland, were issued.
