Q.203. Mr. Govan, what is your present appointment?

Sir, I am the Medical Officer attached to the Canadian Scottish Regiment, C.A.

Q.204. Evidence has been given to this Court that K.605820, Pte. H. W. Rushworth was confined to hospital for a period of 71 days from the 4th June 43 to the 13th August 43. Would you inform the Court as to all the costs to the Crown for the hospitalization of Pte. Rushworth for that time.

For the period of 71 days in which the charge was hospitalized the cost of daily hospitalization would be \$2.50 and the total would be \$177.50.

Q.205. Does that cost include everything?

That is an approximate cost, as close as I can estimate.

Q.206. Is that based on an accepted figure?

That is the average cost of hospitalization in all army military hospitals.
