

FORM OF BEQUEST.

A Bequest of money, or Shares of Stock, or Debentures for the University of King's College, Windsor:

I give and bequeath to "The Governors of the University of King's College, Windsor, Nova Scotia," the sum of dollars (or share of stock in the standing in my name in the books of the said), or (if debentures, describe them briefly), upon trust, to be applied by the said "Governors" to and for the uses and purposes of the said University.

A Devise of Real Estate for the general purposes of the University:

I give and devise to "The Governors of the University of King's College, Windsor, Nova Scotia," all and singular, etc., (describe the Real Estate clearly). To have and to hold the said, etc., unto the said Governors and their successors for ever; upon trust, to hold and apply the same, and the rents, issues and profits thereof, and the proceeds of the sale thereof should the Governors sell the same, to and for the uses and purposes of the said University. If bequeathed or devised towards any particular object or towards the endowment of any particular chair, to be altered accordingly.
