Principal Stewart's arguments were warmly endorsed by Principal C. J. Mersereau of Chatham, who especially emphasized the importance of a teachers' union, as teachers were not paid in proportion to their efficiency and could only obtain their right when they unitedly demanded them. The last session convened at 2 p.m.

The following resolutions (recommended by H. H. Stuart, Miss Tessies A. Gallivan and L. R. Hethering ion) were adopted section by section and as a whole:

1. That the teaching of Latin and Algebra be eliminated from Grades VII and VIII and the time saved thereby devoted to English and Arithmetic, the latter study to be finished in Grade VIII.

2. That the Compulsory Education Act be amended so as to render it obligatory and sompletely effective in all districts, and that any clauses of the Factory Act in any way conflicting therewith should be repealed.

3. That Consolidation of schools in tural districts, and that any clauses of the Factory Act in any way conflicting therewith should be repealed.

3. That Alanual Training, School Gardening and Household Science should be made obligatory in all cases where practicable.

4. That Manual Training, School Gardening and Household Science should be made obligatory in all schools of the province.
