The Chairman: Shall the bill carry?

Some hon. Members: Carried.

Bill reported.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: When shall the bill be read a third time?

Some hon. Members: By leave, now.

Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale): Leave is not required, Mr. Speaker.

Mr. Aiken: Certainly it is, there have been amendments.

Mr. Jamieson moved the third reading of the bill.

Motion agreed to and bill read the third time and passed.

REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES ACT

MEASURE TO PROVIDE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF PRODUCTIVE EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES—REPORT STAGE

The house resumed consideration of Bill C-202, to provide incentives for the development of productive employment opportunities in regions of Canada determined to require special measures to facilitate economic expansion and social adjustment, as reported (with amendments) from the Standing Committee on Regional Development, and motion No. 5 Mr. Broadbent.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: The question is on motion No. 5; Mr. Broadbent, is it the pleasure of the house to adopt the said motion?

Some hon. Members: Yes.

Some hon. Members: No.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: All those in favour of the amendment will please say yea?

Some hon. Members: Yea.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: All those opposed will please say nay.

Some hon. Members: Nay.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: In my opinion the nays have it, and I declare the motion negated on division.

Motion No. 5, Mr. Broadbent, negated on division.

Mr. John Burton (Regina East) moved:

That Bill C-202, to provide incentives for the development of productive employment opportunities in regions of Canada determined to require special measures to facilitate economic expansion and social adjustment, be amended in clause 13, section 2, by adding after the word "made" in line 23 on page 10, the words:

"or the 31st day of December, 1976, whichever is earlier.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: Is it the pleasure of the house to adopt the said motion?

Mr. John L. Skoberg (Moose Jaw): Mr. Chairman, in dealing with the amendment which has been proposed to this clause of the bill, I believe there has been a slight error in the drafting of it. I should like at this time to read the amendment that we wish to put. It is as follows:

That the motion be amended by deleting therefrom the word "earlier" and substituting therefor the word "later".

I am sure the minister realizes there was some discussion in the Committee as to the application of the amount of loans that industry would be allowed. It was thought that the reason for providing incentives for industries to move into an area was related to a benefit to the people who were unemployed. Good corporate citizenship is expected of any
