U. S. NATIONAL GUARD CAMP IN A PANIC SOLDIERS KILLED AND INJURED BY LIGHTNING

GETTYSBURG, Pa., July 24.—An all night storm, with lightning, rain and hail, where 10,000 of the national guard of Pennsylvania have been camped for a week and which was visited last night by a terrific electrical and wind storm, shows that three soldiers were killed by lightning and that nearly half a hundred others were injured.

They were all thrown to the ground by the falling canvas, but managed to get out of the tent in a blue flame when he was enveloped in a blue flame following a terrific crash and fell dead. The other soldier, Paul Neil, was only stunned. In the case of each of those killed, the new army puttees issued just before the men went into camp, were torn from their legs and the steel ribbing exposed. Some of the officers believe the steel attracted the lightning.
