An Act to repeal several Laws relating to the Fisheries carried on upon the Banks and Shores of *Newfoundland*, and to make Provision for the better Conduct of the said Fisheries for Five Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament. [3d June 1824.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal and amend divers Statutes and Laws relating to the Fisheries on the Banks and Shores of *Newfoundland*, and to make such further Provisions as the present State and Condition of the Colony require; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the Act passed in the Tenth and Eleventh Year of the Reign of His Majesty King *William* the Third, intituled *An Act to encourage the Trade to Newfoundland*; and so much of another Act passed in the Fifteenth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King *George* the Third, intituled *An Act for the Encouragement of the Fisheries carried on from Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions in Europe; and for securing the Return of*
