Uplands, Ontario	8-8-42		Clear, becoming cloudy. No flying all day, because of the poor weather. Training Wing put in another day of Physical Training and Drill.		
	9-8-42		Raining all day. No flying. Divine Services were held in the Recreation Hall in the morning.		
	10-8-42		Showers and thunder showers. No flying again today due to poor flying weather.		
	11-8-42		Overcast, showers. The Officers from D.A.P.S. played the Officers of Uplands in the evening, and after the game they adjourned to the Mess for Dinner.		
	12-8-42		Clear. Queen Wilhelmina, Queen of the Netherlands, accompanied by the Earl of Athlone and Princess Alice, visited the Station. The R.C.A.F. Band was on hand for the occasion and gave a demonstration of a musical march on the Parade Grounds. Training Wing provided an exhibition of formation flying. At the conclusion of this, the Queen and party were entertained at Tea in the Officers' Mess. At 0015 hours, in Harvard 3041, RL37149, LAC Haas, J.R., ground-looped at main aerodrome. Pilot failed to correct swing on landing. Only slight damage to aircraft.
