I could not forbear putting this view into
my letter because it is such a good and
true one, and lends so much more
force to my description. To the left you
see the hills below Camp, to the right
and in the center the tops of the
Dent de Midi. and in the foreground
the Chateau, with the town of St. Ville
nearly in the background. Chillon
is but one of many chateaux on the
lake shore, and in the neighbor-
hood - they are here there and
everywhere, as are also the inter-
esting Swiss villages each with
its old church, and often a clock
tower. Last Saturday when I made
a bicycle excursion along the lake
shore I passed through six or seven
villages finally getting to St. Pons
kungen, a dozen miles from Lausanne
and coming back by the lake steamer.
