It was not for the sake of expression merely that Pasteur characterized the law of peace, work, and health as one, or that its constituent elements were mentioned by him in the order named. Peace and Health are essential to Work, and work is the surest means of maintaining both. Without work, neither peace nor health would be possible, any more than without peace work and health would long continue, or without health, work and peace be possible. The three are indissolubly united, and it is impossible to be indifferent to any one without at the same time adversely affecting the other two. Whilst, therefore, for the sake of a minute analysis this single law may be divided into its component elements, and each studied apart as if it were a separate law of itself, it is important to remember that the effective application of any one element presupposes the application of the other two, and this not merely within industry, but also within the area, however wide, within which industry is carried on. As regards the relations of its component elements, and the relations of industry and the community with respect thereto, the law "runneth both forward and back."
