The title of the plan is to be "Plan of Indian Reserve No.61 B, situated in the N.W. of Tp.19, R.20, W.1.M. "Man."

Your plan should be signed and dated the day that you finish the survey. It is especially desired that one or more Indians of the Bend, who should be the Chief and Councillor, or selected by them, be employed in making the survey, and or that they may be fully informed of the limits of the reserve. Kindly communicate with Mr.G.H.Wheatley, Indian Agent, Birth, who will be pleased to render you any assistance that may be in his power.
