It is especially desired that one or more Indians of the Band, who should be the Chief and Councillor, or men selected by them, be employed in making the survey, in order that they may be fully informed of the limits of the reserve. Kindly communicate with Mr. G. H. Wheatley, Indian Agent, Battle Lake, who will be pleased to render you any assistance that may be in his power.
