Commendations, military or civil, are granted only for brave conduct or for services in the air. Mentions in Despatches are granted as heretofore for gallantry and for good service and confined to operations against the enemy.

The names and descriptions of the individuals mentioned or commended will be inserted in red in manuscript resembling the type in the printed document. The arrangements made for this have been communicated to the Admiralty, War Office and Air Ministry and to the Central Chancery of the Orders of Knighthood.

Certificates 1 to 5 will be despatched by the Central Chancery and Certificates 6 to 12 by the Admiralty, War Office or Air Ministry, as the case may be.
