1. Returned herewith are the Proceedings of
the marginally-noted Standing Court-Martial for registra-
tion and safekeeping.

2. The time between the return of the soldier
to his unit (21st September, 1944) and trial (25th September,
1944)

is four days.

The time between apprehension and trial is four days.

3. The question of the present position of this
soldier's wife and family has been taken up with the District
Social Service Officer who is seeing what can be done about
the situation.

It is also noted that this soldier was, dur-
ing his absence, employed by the Government hauling supplies
to the Internment Camp at Seebe. This has been drawn to the
attention of the National Selective Service Board in this City.

4. Upon review, no remission has been ordered by
the District Officer Commanding, Military District No. 13.
