RECORD of the Declaration of a Court of Inquiry assembled at Tournay Barracks Farnborough, Hants on the 20th day of December 1943, for the purpose of investigating and recording the absence, without leave, from his duty, and deficiency, if any, in the Arms, Ammunition, Equipments, Instruments, Regimental Necessaries, or Clothing of No. C.21715, Pte Quennville, L., Cameron Highlanders of Ottawa, on strength of 5 Canadian Infantry Reinforcement Unit

DECLARATION

The Court declare that No. C.21715, Pte Quennville, L., Cameron Highlanders of Ottawa, on strength of 5 Canadian Infantry Reinforcement Unit illegally absented himself without leave from Tournay Barracks, Farnborough, Hants 5 Canadian Infantry Reinforcement Unit at 2359 hrs on the 27th day of November, 1943, that he is still so absent, and that on the 10th December 1943 he was deficient, and that he is still deficient of the following articles:-
