One six months course.

Practical Anatomy.

It being understood that so long as the Statuto passed during the last Session of the Provincial Parliament, entitled, "An Act to repeal a certain Act or Ordinance therein mentioned, and to provide effectual regulations concerning the Practice of Physic, Surgery, and Midwifery," continues in force in its present form; such Students, as are qualifying themselves to practice within this Province, cannot receive their Degree of Doctor in Medicine and Surgery, until after a course of five years study, unless they consent to undergo the examination required by the aforesaid Provincial Statute.
