And a further sum of Twenty Pounds to Elizabeth Chappell, for conducting the business of the Inland Mails, for the past year.

17001. for Roads and Bridges.

And a further sum of One thousand seven hundred Pounds, for the service of Roads and Bridges-to be expended agreeably to the Report of the Committee of the House of Assembly, appointed for the consideration of all matters relating to Roads and Bridges.

501. for building a Bridge over Hermitage Creek.

And a further sum of Fifty Pounds, to defray the expense of building a Bridge over Hermitage Creek, in addition to the sum already granted for that purpose.

140%, for making a Road between Montague, on Lot 59, and the Wood -Island Settlement, on Lot 62.

· And a further sum of One hundred and Forty Pounds, towards defraying the expense of making a Road of communication between Montague, on Township Number Fifty-nine, and the Wood Islands Settlement, on Township Number Sixtytwo, as laid off by the Surveyor General in the Year One thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, under the Act for regulating the laying out and altering of Highways.
