

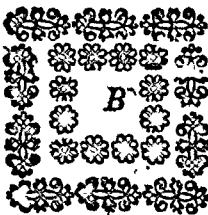

For the Regulating *Innholders, Tavernkeepers, and Retailers* of Spirituous Liquors.



*E*t it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That from and after the Publication hereof no Retailer, Innholder, Tavern or Alehouse Keeper, who shall sell upon Trust or Credit, any Wine, Strong Beer, Ale, Brandy, Rum, or other Spirituous Liquors, mixt or unmixt, to any Soldier, Sailor, Servant, or Day Labourer, or other Person whatsoever, to the Amount of any Sum exceeding the Sum of
