Certain accounts were certified as correct, amongst them one from Mr. John Anderson, Registrar, Arthur, of \$106, which included an item of nearly \$60 for office cleaning. The ellowance of the accounts of Mrs. Nichols and the Master in Chancery, as they had been previously reported on, and no further evidence was furnished. The com-mittee recumended that the Clerk of the Paace be paid any sum necessarily expended in providing proper office a ac-commodiation for documents, &.e., in his charge, but they cannot recommend that any payment on account of rent, as they are preparal to furnish a suitable office in the County Buildings. They recommend that ach actuels asked for by the gaoler be purchased for the use of the Prisoners. Mr. Pieterson was allowed to address the Council in reference to his office ac-commodation as Clerk of the Pence. He said that the late Mr. Saunders occu-pied only one small room in the Registry Office, and that he (Mr. Peterson) had been requested to vacate this. Two rooms were absolutely necessary, with a fir-proof vault for the preservation of the important records in his possession. If had been suggested that i e should have the room next the County Treasurer's office. It would not take it, for it was entirely unsuitable and inconvenient. If the Council could not find him proper office accommodation they ought to pay his reasonable demand for the cost of unishing it himself. The papers of the late Clerk of the Pence were left in a la-mentable state of confusion, owing doub-less to the want of office rooms.
