

RAILWAY SHARES REMAIN STRONG

Main Tendency on Wall Street Is Upward, With New Records Made.

New York, Oct. 24.—Noon.—The main trend continued upward throughout the morning. The rapidity with which some stocks advanced on a small turn-over indicated a scarcity in the floating supply at current levels, which probably accounted for some active short covering in various sections of the list.

New favorite, Illinois Central, and eastern Illinois preferred rising 3/4 points, and Rutland preferred 3/4, the latter at a new high. Bethlehem Steel common was strong, but the preferred issues were heavy.

Also were in supply, while American Woolen preferred broke through 18, previous high. Leather preferred, United States Alcohol and Goodyear preferred extended their gains to 2 points or more.
