The job is done now and the long hard fence-line has been drawn clear to the Arctic. It is known now where Canada ends and Alaska begins.

The first part of the boundary located was that from Portland Canat, the southernmost point, to Mount Ellas the boundary follows the 141st meridian if in a bee-line to the Arctic, a distance of about six hundred miles.

In general the marking of the line was done in three ways: By the place of a ridge or mountains got the line was done in three ways: By the place of a ridge or mountain spur, a monument was placed in the form of an aluminum-bronze cone. These monuments which vary from fifty to nearly three hundred p indis, were securely set in rock or concrete beds, so they shall be permanent marks of the boundary.

When the surveyors came to a belt of timber, they cut a sky-line through the claring ten feet on each side of the meridian, and so making an international right-of-way twenty feet wide.

The getting of all this data and the location of the meridian frequently made necessary the climbing of ugly mountains, sore of the peaks being eight and ten thousand feet high. Glaciers were scaled, and perilous ascents made, all in order that the boundary might be rightly determined.
