



GENTLEMEN .--

I am in receipt of your inquiry respecting the No. 126 Gurney Boiler you furnished me with last Winter for my Forcing-houses, and in reply would beg to give you the following items which the Boiler is doing.

3 houses (stauding in very exposed position) (14 ft. x 60 span roofed) North and South.

3 rows of 3 inch pipe, 450 feet in all. Cost of fuel for eight days' trial during severest part of winter with Egg Coal, houses ranging from 50 degrees at night to 65 or 70 degrees in the day, amounted to 51 cents per day, or an average of 17 cents each house, and a further trial with cheap fuel gave good results at a much less cost. The Boiler would run a fourth house and then have power to spare. For Greenhouse work as an independent Boiler without brick work, notwithstanding any assertion which may be made to the contrary, the Gurney Heater is all that can be desired. Give it a good long draft and it will far surpass all expectations.

I may add that the Boiler standing inside the centre house and not being troubled in any way with the gas the whole of the heat generated is economized.
