Though I feel persuaded that she does not stand in need of our assistance, still the judgment of God is far different from that of man; I have therefore recommended her to the prayers of my religious brethren, who voluntarily acquiesced. In devotion, I shall endeavor to surpass them, as I hold her in singular esteem and veneration. As a favor, I beg some part of her relics. I can assert with confidence that I have never known a person possessed of greater virtue. I have often been struck with that greatness of soul, that lively faith, that entire confidence in God, that sweet devotion, undaunted zeal, profound humility, and heroic mortification which ever shone forth in this rare example of the 17th Century."

I here conclude willingly, leaving my readers to dwell on the testimony of individuals so eminently *enlightened* and distinguished.
