The capacity of the Welland Railway has just been most satisfactorily tested. The cargo of the Schooner *Farnham*, consisting of 12,500 Bushels of Grain, was transferred to 27 Cars in a few hours time, and brought over the Road to Port Dalhousie by one Locomotive with the greatest ease. The weight of the load was over 350 Tons, and it is estimated by the Superintendent that 380 Tons can be brought over the line by one Locomotive. This announcement cannot fail to be satisfactory to all who take an interest in the Western Trade.
