

2. Clause two of the Principal Agreement is struck out and the following substituted therefor:

"2. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the Minister on behalf of Canada agrees to lend to the Government of the Netherlands, such amounts not exceeding One Hundred and Twenty-Five Million Dollars (Canadian) (less any amounts advanced to the Government of the Netherlands under the said Agreement of 1st May, 1945) as may from time to time be requisitioned from the Minister by the Government of the Netherlands to enable the Government of the Netherlands or any person ordinarily resident in the Netherlands to purchase from exporters, and to pay the cost of Canadian-produced goods exported or to be exported from Canada to the Netherlands and to pay the cost of Canadian services."

3. Clause four of the said Principal Agreement is struck out and the following substituted therefor:

"4. The Government of the Netherlands agrees that the moneys received by it under this agreement and the said agreement of 1st May, 1945, will be used only by it or by persons ordinarily resident in the Netherlands to whom it transfers any of such moneys, and only for the purpose of paying the cost of Canadian-produced goods purchased from exporters and exported or to be exported to the Netherlands and the cost of Canadian services."
