Excellency,

I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of your Note of today's date concerning the Convention on the Presence of Foreign Forces in the Federal Republic of Germany of October 23, 1954, the English text of which reads as follows:

(See German Note of September 25, 1990)

I have the honor to inform you that the Government of the United States of America agrees to the content of Your Excellency's Note. Accordingly, Your Excellency's Note, this reply and the replies of the Ambassador of the Kingdom of Belgium, of the Ambassador of Canada, of the Ambassador of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and of the Ambassador of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland expressing their Governments' agreement shall constitute an Agreement between our Governments, which shall enter into force today.
