It is emphasized that the report is not a compilation of draft proposals, but that public discussion is necessary before the "blueprints" are drawn up. The report will be discussed by the House committee, which is expected to make recommendations.

Whether the whole system of social security should be brought into operation at one time or in some ordered sequence is left to be decided by the Congress at the time of the report's transmission and of other items of post-war policy as well as by public opinion.

The benefits rates suggested also are not forward as subjects for further discussion.

In the administration of the social security system, the Federal Government and the States will not be working in isolation. The Federal Government will work out a clear understanding with the States as to their respective responsibilities.
