1. House to go into Committee to consider certain proposed Resolutions granting subsidies (money) towards the construction of certain Railways, 857. His Excellency's recommendation signified, 859. In Committee; Resolutions adopted, 865. Reported, read the second time, and agreed to, 867.
2. Bill (No. 175) to authorize the granting of subsidies in aid of the construction of the lines of Railway therein mentioned: Mr. Bowell, 867. Read second time; considered in Committee; reported with amendments; considered as amended, 875. Order for third reading discharged; Bill re-committed; reported with further amendments; considered as amended; read third time; passed, 882. Passed by Senate, 920. Royal Assent, 921.—54-55 Victoria, Chapter 8.
3. House to go into Committee of the Whole to consider a Resolution granting subsidies in land to the Red Deer Valley Railway and Coal Company and the Canadian Pacific Railway Company; His Excellency's recommendation signified: Mr. Dewdney, 276. In Committee; Resolution adopted, 455. Resolution reported, 608. Amended; read second time and agreed to, 609.
4. Bill (No. 169) further to amend the Act fifty-second Victoria, Chapter four, intituled: "An Act to authorize the granting of subsidies in land to certain Railway Companies"; presented: Mr. Dewdney, 609. Read second time, 629. Considered in Committee, and progress reported, 635, 636. Again considered; reported, 727. Passed by Senate, 916. Royal Assent, 921.—54-55 Victoria, Chapter 9.
5. House to go into Committee to consider certain proposed Resolutions granting subsidies in land to certain railway companies, etc.; His Excellency's recommendation signified, 478. In Committee; progress reported, 727, 818. Again in Committee; Resolutions adopted, 821. Reported and agreed to, 839.
6. Bill (No. 173) to authorize the granting of subsidies in land to certain railway companies: Mr. Dewdney, 839. Read second time; considered in Committee; reported; read third time; passed, 865. Passed by Senate, 916. Royal Assent, 921.—54-55 Victoria, Chapter 10.
7. Order—Return of the names of the several railways of the Dominion to which aid has been granted; Province, County, amount granted, etc.: Mr. McMullen, 251. Presented, 694. *Printed (Sessional Papers)*. Sess. Papers, No. 34c.
