

- Printing (b) The Joint Committee on the Printing of Parliament to which shall be appointed twenty-one senators.
- Restaurant (c) The Joint Committee on the Restaurant of Parliament to which shall be appointed the Speaker and six other senators.
- Regulations and other Statutory Instruments (d) The Joint Committee on Regulations and other Statutory Instruments to which shall be appointed eight senators.
- Standing Rules and Orders (e) The Committee on Standing Rules and Orders, composed of fifteen members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, which is empowered on its own initiative to propose to the Senate amendments to the rules from time to time.
- Internal Economy, Budgets and Administration (f) The Committee on Internal Economy, Budgets and Administration, composed of fifteen members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, which is empowered on its own initiative to consider any matter relating to the internal economy of the Senate, including budgetary matters and administration generally, and to report the result of such consideration to the Senate.
- Foreign Affairs (g) The Senate Committee on Foreign Affairs, composed of twelve members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, to which shall be referred, if there is a motion to that effect, bills, messages, petitions, inquiries, papers and other matters relating to foreign and commonwealth relations generally, including:
- (i) treaties and international agreements;
 - (ii) external trade;
 - (iii) foreign aid;
 - (iv) defence;
 - (v) territorial and offshore matters.
- National Finance (h) The Senate Committee on National Finance, composed of twelve members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, to which shall be referred, if
