Referring to telephone conversation 26th instant.

This will confirm our advice that 125 male delegates accompanied by 75 ladies are expected from Europe.

This group will naturally be interested in power development and it is felt that if they could be invited to inspect power plants at Niagara Falls, they might then be induced to visit Toronto and Montreal were an invitation extended by the Shawinigan Power people.
