In compliance therefore with the wifnes of their friends, and a defire of being useful to mankind, they commit the following fheets to the prefs; and at the fame time inform their readers, that they contain a faithful description of that Country, and its produce, without a defire of reprefenting it in any other view, or making it either better or worfe, than it appeared to them on their most mature judgment of it. They have be-fides added an account of feveral effates in the different Townships through which they paffed, that are to be fold, fpecifying the number of acres each contains, and the prices at which they are fet.
