No person, or persons, will be allowed to exhibit any article for competition that does not belong to them. Any person, or persons, so doing will forfeit their right to any premiums to which they might otherwise be entitled. No person, or persons, will be allowed to enter for competition more than one specimen of any article in any section of this list, (except in Class 1st,) unless the additional article be of a distinct name, variety, or pattern from the first.

**If it be ascertained that any exhibitor has intentionally made, or caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal, or article, exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall forfeit his or her right to any premiums to which he or she might otherwise be entitled.**

Any animal, or article, entered for exhibition in one Class cannot compete for a premium in any other. The Judges will be selected from different sections of the country, but will not be made public until the Exhibition. Persons from other Counties may compete in Classes 3 and 4 by paying the entrance fee, as above mentioned.

The Judges are particularly requested not to give encouragement to over-fed animals in the breeding classes. When articles, or animals, are not deemed worthy of a premium, the Judges will refuse to award one.

Agricultural produce will be mostly judged by appearance, and weights will be used only when the Judges cannot decide without them.

There will be no prize awarded to any machine, or article, in Class 3rd, unless there is some new improvement for the old ones to compete with.
