The basis is a fund to be provided by small fixed assessments upon each employe. The company will pay all deficiencies in the relief fund. The employes who join the fund will be divided into three classes. Those who receive a monthly pay of less than and less than \$75; and the third class including all employes receiving more than \$75. Monthly payments will be at the rate of 75 cents for the first class: \$1.50 for the second class, and \$3 for the third class.
