Notre-Dame Hospital was established for the cure and reliet of the sick, without distinction of race or creed. In addition to these, two ladies of the same community come to the Hospital every evening to watch the sick during the night.

The Hospital has a Catholic chaplain or almoner, who provides the help and consolation of religion to all who stand in need of it.
