Appleton Says C. N. R. Profits at \$40,000,000 to December

MONCTON, Dec. 3.—W. U. Appleton, general manager of the Atlantic region, Canadian National Railways, speaking here tonight, gave data on the progress of the system. Mr. Appleton pointed out that by the end of this month the gross revenue for the calendar year will be \$266,900,000 and that net profits will reach approximately \$40,000,000, bringing the total net for the past four years to approximately \$100,000,000.
