QUARTER MILLION LOSS IN FOREST FIRES Fredericton, N.B., June 17.—Latest reports from Kedgewick, the lumbering village on the Intercolonial Railway which was almost destroyed during the week-end by the most disastrous forest fire for some time in New Brunswick are that the loss will be not less than \$250,000. Thirty-one houses, nine barns and three lumber mills were destroyed and the fire is declared to have swept over a territory twenty miles in length and about a mile and a half in widths No human lives were lost but some cattle and other live stock are said to have been burned to death while several people are reported to have been severely scorched by flames.
