

BUSINESS TO WHICH PRESBYTERIES ARE REQUIRED
TO GIVE ATTENTION.

1. The election of a representative to the Sustentation Board, by each Presbytery, at the meeting held last before next meeting of Synod, (vide Minutes, 1870, pp. 27).
2. To take steps to have all arrears to the Synod Fund paid by defaulting Kirk-Sessions within their bounds.
3. To take steps to have all arrears to the Widows' and Orphans' Fund paid by defaulting congregations within their bounds. (Minutes, pp. 35).
4. Presbyteries are required to inquire at each ordinary meeting and record in their minutes, what congregations within their bounds have made the Special Collection or Collections in behalf of the Schemes of the Church falling due since their previous meeting. (Act anent Public Collections, Minutes, pp. 68).
5. To make full and immediate returns to the Widows' and Orphans' Board in regard to such Ministers within their bounds as have wives and children. (Minutes pp. 36).
6. To forward to Mr. Croil a list of the apportionments to each congregation of the annual contribution required from the Presbytery to the Sustentation Fund. (Minutes, pp. 37).
7. To consider and report to next meeting of Synod on the following Overtures:—
 - (1) Anent the status of Ministers engaged in the work of French Evangelization. (Minutes, pp. 37).
 - (2) Anent shortening the curriculum in certain cases. (Minutes, pp. 43).
 - (3) Anent Retired Ministers. (Minutes, pp. 66).
 - (4) Anent Joint Meetings of Elders and Managers. Minutes, pp. 69).
