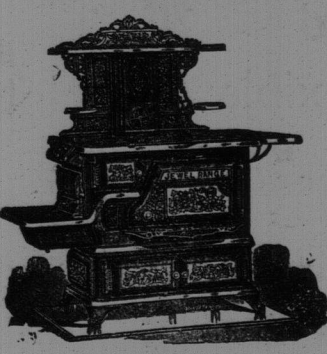

NOMINATION DAY.

THE PROCEEDINGS AT THE COURT HOUSE.

A Big Crowd Present—Sheriff Harding presiding. The nominations were made by the following gentlemen:

By two o'clock the nomination court was opened by Sheriff Harding. He first read the writs authorizing him to hold the court and announced that he had sent out notices of the election according to the directions he had received. He then called upon the electors to nominate each person as they deemed suitable to represent the city and county of St. John in the House of Commons of Canada.
