Sir:-

Referring to your letter of the 15th instant, I beg to say that a flag has been ordered from Messrs. Bronley & Hague for the Chief of the Shoal River Band. Pictures of the King and Queen are being sent to your address under separate cover for the Chief. With regard to your request for a medal, I may say that the Department is not quite satisfied with the explanation that the Chief never received a medal, as it is under the impression that he had one. In this connection I beg to refer you to the Department's letter of the 17th August, 1910 addressed to Mr. Agent Logan in reply to his letter of the 10th August No. 116. You should on your next visit to the Shoal River Reserve, make further enquiries in regard to this medal.
