Of Irish and English parentage. B. in Halifax, N.S., 5 Nov., 1835. Ed. there. M. Sarah, eld. dau. of Zecharia Adams, Esq., of St. John. Has been connected with the N. B. press for many years. Established *Western Borderer* (Carleton) 1857, and about the same time the *Freemasons' Monthly Monitor*. Was chief ed. of the *Courier* (St. John), and since 1863 has been ed. and prop. of the *Daily Morning News*, same city. Has held various offices in the Grand Lodge of A. F. & A. M. of N.B. Was an unsuccessful candidate for present seat, 1867. First returned at last g. e.—*Princess St., St. John.*
