

"rectly, be a dealer in, or interested in the buying or selling of any article of lumber, either on my own account, or on account of any other person or persons whatsoever; and that I will act without partiality, favour or affection, and to the best of my knowledge.—*So help me God.*"

Which oath and bond shall be filed and kept among the records of the office of the Registrar of this Province.

II. *And be it enacted*, That it shall and may be lawful for the Board of Trade in Quebec, to constitute and appoint in that City at least seven, and not more than eleven persons, one of whom shall be the Supervisor, to be a Board to examine and test the skill and qualifications of all applicants to be admitted and commissioned as Cullers; and such Board shall meet from time to time, as circumstances may require, at the office of the Board of Trade, or of the Supervisor, to test the skill, capacity and qualification of such applicants; and such Board of Examiners shall meet at the office of the Supervisor, or Board of Trade room, to wit: on the first Mondays of January and May in each year, to examine and test the skill, capacity and qualifications of all applicants for licences as Cullers, and each member of the said Board, before acting as such, shall take the following oath, (to be administered by a Justice of the Peace for the said City of Quebec) that is to say:

"I, A. B., do solemnly swear, that I will not, directly or indirectly, personally or by means of any other person or persons on my behalf, re-
