

Lot 8016 - 7th Con. Indian Lands
30th March 1850

To
D. H. Napier Esq

Sir

In compliance with
a public notice issued from the Indian
Office Canada East dated Montreal 18th
June last in regard to the lands lying
in the tract of the St. Regis Indian Reservation
in the County of Glengarry, I am induced
to forward as therein directed the following
statement of facts.

Upon the 7th Decemr 1844 I purchased
from Mr John McCall his possession of a
certain lot of land which was then known
as Lot letter C in the 6th Con: of the
Township of Roxburgh for the sum of
Fifty five pounds cy. this lot was
then understood to be Clergy Reserve
land as appears from a letter in my
possession dated Commissioner of Crown Lands
Office 8th Aug 1836 wherein McCall was
acknowledged as being in possession of the
lot at that time, but that the day of
sale had not been fixed, and the
matter remained so until the time
of my purchasing McCall's possession
