The Deputy Minister, -

In regard to letter from Mr. W. M. Jones, Provincial Superintendent, Soldier Settlement Board, Toronto, Ont., I beg to say that lots 41 and 42, Long Sault reserve, are situate within the tract which was surrendered by the Indians some time ago to be sold for their benefit. Lot 41^{which} contains an area of 89.57 acres, is valued at \$895.70, and lot 42, which contains an area of 170.51 acres, is valued at \$1193.57, or a total value of \$2,089.27. These lots are open for disposition, and upon payment of the price above stated, could be transferred to the Soldier Settlement Board.
