Dear Mr. King:-

I am sending you under separate cover twenty five copies of the Questions and Answers bearing on the Bethlehem Plan of Representation and shall be very glad to furnish you with any additional information you may want from time to time.

Mr. Grace was interested to know that you had returned from Europe and wished me to say that he hoped you would let us know when you next intended to be in New York as he would be very much interested to hear of your observations on the British Labor Situation.

In reference to the steel trade strike, I believe the action taken to date is that the twenty four Presidents representing the organized trades in the iron and steel industry held a meeting in Pittsburgh on July 20th, at which they voted to call for a strike
