Dec.30/42	<u>Canada-U.S. Joint Economic Committees - study of North Pacific Coast - Canadian to be appointed co-director.</u>	E.A.	A meeting was held of Canadian Section of Joint Economic Committees, at which it was decided that Dr. Camsell should be proposed as Canadian Co-Director of the proposed study and that he should have the assistance of a specialist. Several names were mentioned and choice was left up to Dr. Camsell. Revised arrangements and press release approved, C.W.C. Jan. 13/43. ✓
Dec.30/42	<u>Canadian Broadcasting Corporation - shortwave radio station.</u> Prime Minister to communicate with U.S. President, subject to advice Minister of Munitions and Supply.	E.A.	Letter from Prime Minister to President of U.S., dated Jan.9 sent by Legation bag Jan.11/43 asking for President's active interest and support in securing priorities for equipment necessary for establishment of short-wave station in Canada. ✓
