In reply to your letter of the Seth instant, No. 189, submitting requests of Indians of Valley River Reserve, I beg to any that you have been authorised to purchase the oxen and harness by letter of yesterdays date, and letter of the 7th June last authorised the purchase of two discs and therefore it is not understood why these are included in your letter.

to the Band desiring to expend the funds coming from timber sold off the reserve to Mr. Sinnet, I beg to say that these funds have not yet reached the Department, so that it is not known what sum will be available for the purpose mentioned.

Mr. Tate is being instructed to collect the dues from Mr. Sinnet and when they are to hand, the matter of allowing them to be used by the Indians in the purchase of building material will receive consideration.
