

of the Privy Council, and Dr. Ollivier, and a further draft has been prepared as a result of the recommendations put forward.

4. The current revision also embodies the suggestions of Judge J.E. Read, who has expressed, informally, his concurrence therein. It is hoped that interdepartmental agreement, on the official level, might be reached at the next meeting which is scheduled for early in the week beginning March 4th.

5. The current revision has not yet been considered, except at the official level. It is, however, proposed, if you agree, to submit the final draft for the consideration of the Cabinet before preparing the documents in final form for transmission to His Majesty.

6. Some of the more significant changes made in revising the Governor General's documents may be summarized as follows:-

- (a) the new Letters Patent revoke both the former Letters Patent and the former Royal Instructions, so that the new Letters Patent, plus the new Commission of Appointment, will be the only Royal documents governing the Office;
