of the Reserve at Missisagau River in
the Province of Canada to Her Majesty
Queen Victoria of their lands in the
Indian Reserve there as described below
to be sold for their benefit -

Know all men by these Presents
That we the undersigned Chief and
principal men of the above
mentioned Reserve -
for and acting on behalf of
our People do hereby renounce,
release, surrender, quit claim,
and yield up unto Our Sovereign
Lady The Queen, her Heirs and
Successors for ever, All and
singular those certain parcels
or tracts of land situated in
the Province of Canada aforesaid,
and in that part of the said
Province known as the District
of Algoma. known as No 11
Indian Reserve on the said
River as described and set
forth in the map or plan
hereby annexed -
