All Liquors imported under the name of Wines, and containing more than forty per cent of spirits of the strength of proof by Syke's Hydrometer, shall be rated as unenumerated Spirits.

Champagne and all other Sparkling Wines, in bottles, containing each not more than one quart, and more than one pint.....\$3 per doz. bottles

Champagne, containing not more than one pint and more than half pint.....\$1.50 per doz. bottles

Champagne, containing not more than half pint.....75c. per doz. bottles

Wines, bottles containing more than one quart each, shall pay in addition to three dollars per dozen bottles, at the rate of one dollar and fifty cents per Imperial gallon on the quantity in excess of one quart per bottle and in addition to the above specific duties an *ad valorem* duty shall be added of 30

Wire, iron and steel, tinned, galvanized or not, 15 gauge or larger... 25

Wire, iron and steel, tinned, galvanized or not, smaller than 16 gauge. Free

Wire, barbed fencing of iron or steel. 1½ cts per lb.

Wire, buckthorn and strip fencing of iron and steel.....1½ cts per lb.

Wire, iron, manufactures of, not elsewhere specified..... 30

Wire of brass or copper, round or flat. Free

Wire Cloth, Brass and Copper. 20

Wire Work, ornamental iron, semaphore wire..... 25

Wire of spring steel, coppered, or tinned, number 9 and smaller... 20

Wire, covered with cotton, linen, silk or other material..... 25

Wire Window Screens..... 35

Wood, and manufactures of, not elsewhere specified—this includes walking canes, osier or willow work, unlined or lined, furnished or unfurnished, dressing cases, caddies, egg stands, bread plates, book slides, card racks, wall brackets, games, stationery racks, splints. 25

Wood, logs, and round and unmanufactured timber, not elsewhere specified..... Free

Woods, not further manufactured than sawn or split, viz.: African Teak, Black Heart, Ebony, Lignum-vita, Red Cedar and Satin Wood. Free

Wood, for fuel, when imported into Manitoba and the North-West.... Free

Wooden Ware, Pails, Tubs, Churns, Brooms, and other Manufactures of Wood not elsewhere specified. 25

Wool, unmanufactured, Hair of Alpaca Goat and other like animals. Free

Wool, class one, viz.: Leicester, Cotswold, Lincolnshire, South Down Combing Wools, or Wools known as Lustre Wools, and all other like Combing Wools such as are grown in Canada..... 3 cents per lb

Wool and Woollens, Manufactured composed wholly or in part of Wool, Worsted, Hair of Alpaca

Goat, or other like animals, viz: Blankets and Flannels of every description, Cloths, Doeskins, Cassimers, Tweeds, Coatings, Overcoatings, cloakings, Felt cloth of every description, not elsewhere specified, Horse Collar Cloth, Yarn, Knitting Yarn, Fingering Yarn, Worsted Yarn, Knitted Goods, viz: Shirts, Drawers and Hosiery not elsewhere specified... 7½ cts. per lb.

Includes skirtings, union skirtings, imitation sealskin in wool; wool tartan plaids, if they can be used for shirtings, fleecy crewels, royal Saxony, Germantown, Shetland and fairy wools, and woolen baize.

Clothing, ready-made, and Wearing Apparel, of every description, including Cloth Caps, and Horse Clothing, shaped, composed wholly or in part of wool, worsted, the hair of Alpaca goat or other like animal, made up by the tailor, seamstress or manufacturer, not otherwise provided for 10 cts. per lb. and 25

Comprises all ready-made clothing for men and boys of cloth, mantles and cloaks of cloth, imitation sealskin (of wool); ladies' felt skirts, balmoral skirts; flannel or union shirts; any other article composed of wool, or wool and cotton, made up or manufactured wholly or in part by the tailor, seamstress or manufacturer.

Woollens—155. All fabrics composed wholly or in part of wool, worsted, the hair of the Alpaca goat or other like animal, not otherwise provided for, on all such goods costing ten cents per yard and under. 22½

156. Costing over ten and under fourteen cents 25

157. Costing fourteen cents and over 27½

As regards items 155, 156 and 157, the half-penny sterling shall be computed as the equivalent of a cent, and large sums in sterling money shall be computed at the same ratio.
