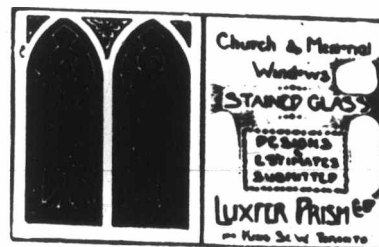

The Bishop of Down has appointed the Rev. T. W. Clarendon, B.D., rector of Magheralin, to the rectorship of Dromore Cathedral.

At St. Peter's, Chicago, there were over 1,000 communicants on Easter Day. A beautiful silver-gold memorial chalice and paten were given to this church at Easter. At Grace Church, Oak Park, the Easter gifts were a set of Eucharistic vestments, silk cassock and festival stole, at the Church of the Epiphany a silver-gold Communion Service, for use with the sick, was presented; at St. James' Church a memorial ewer for the font was given, and at the Church of the Atonement, Edgewater, a pair of handsome silver-mounted cruets; at Church of Christ, Joliet, a silver ciborium was given. All the churches were either in Chicago itself or in the vicinity of the city.
